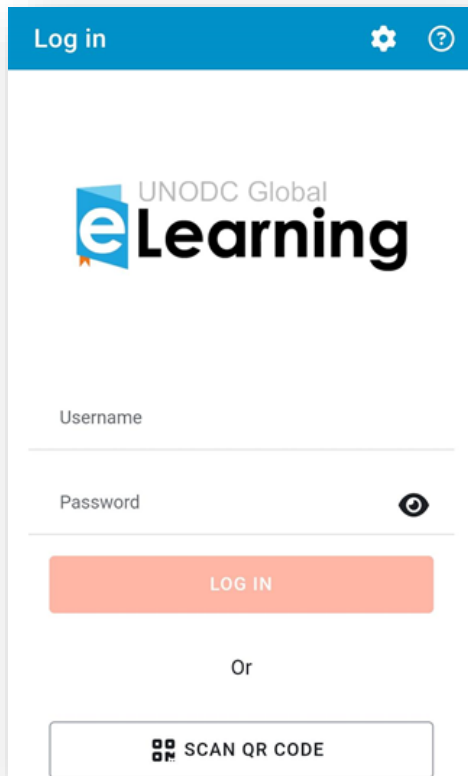

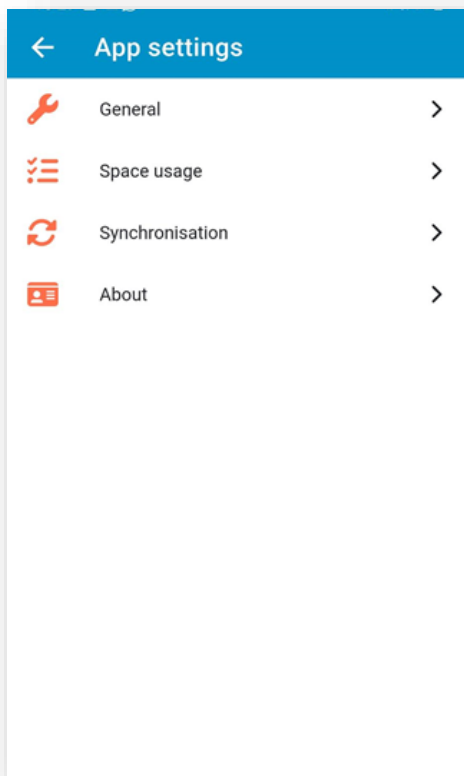

Adjust your settings




To get started, select the Settings button to choose your preferred language, text size and technical settings.

Register a new account


You will need to create an account in order to take courses and receive certificates.

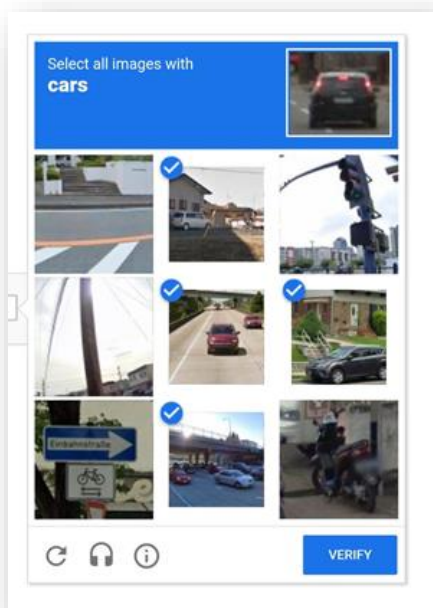

You will receive a confirmation email. You will need to select the link in the email to activate your new account.

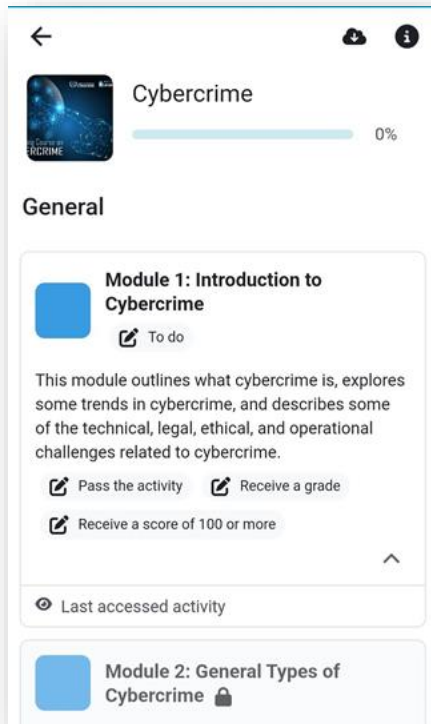
Log in and take courses



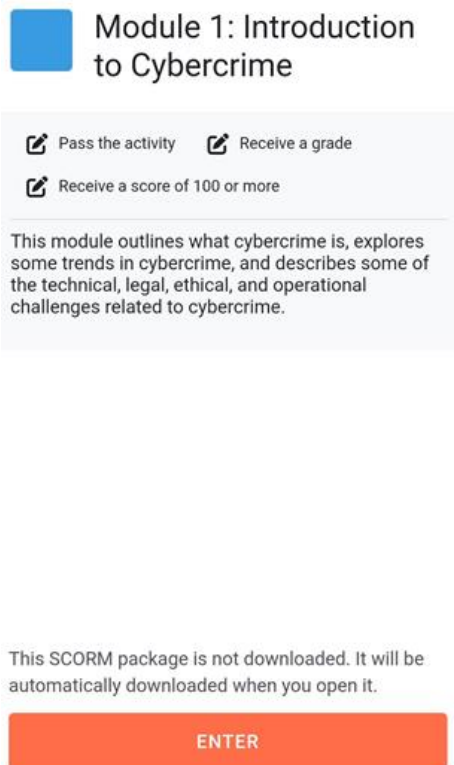
Fill in your username and password and select "Log in."



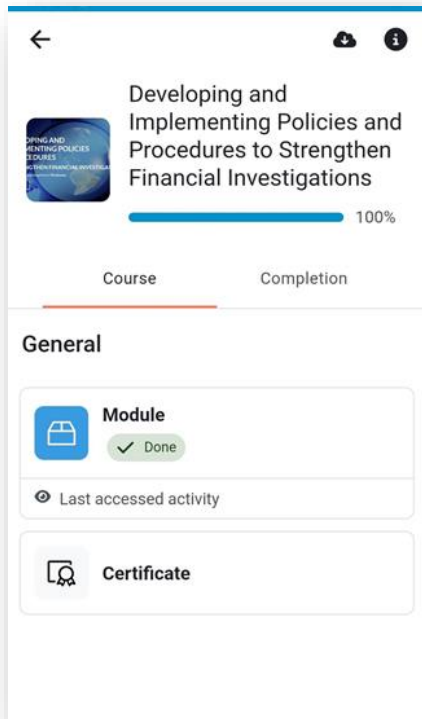
Explore the course catalogue by selecting "Course categories" to browse all courses or "Search courses" to look for a specific course.



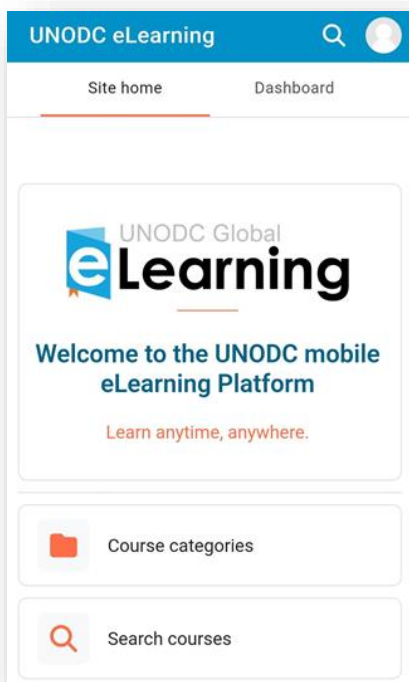
For each course, select the modules in order to take them.



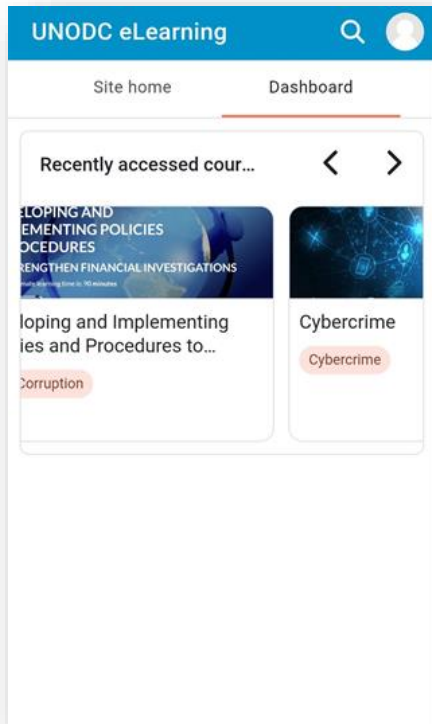
When you select to "Enter" a module, it will download onto your device. You can then take the module even when you have no internet connection.



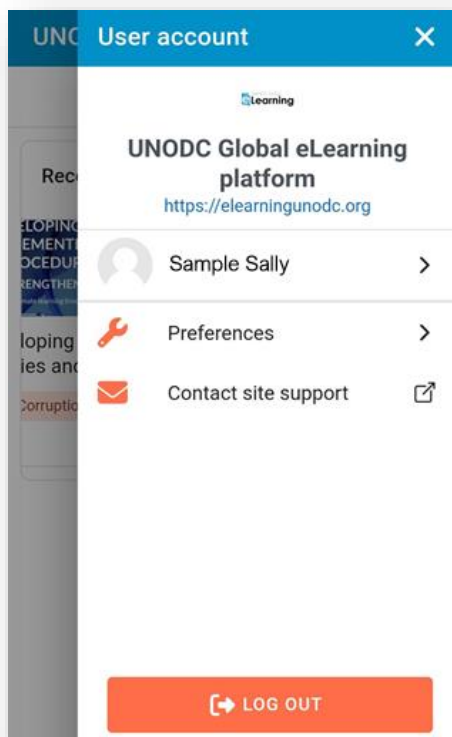
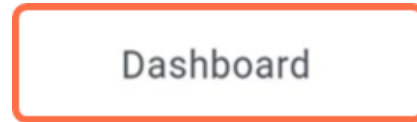
Your progress for all modules you took offline will sync once you connect to the internet again. You will then be able to download your certificate. You will also receive the certificate by email.
